The <u>Independent Restaurant Coalition</u> noted that 56% of restaurants have at least 50% in new debt as a result of COVID-19.

"The disproportionate impact COVID-19 has had on communities of color makes it imperative that firms like ours take action," said Lynn Loacker, head of Davis Wright Tremaine's Project W initiative, which supports women entrepreneurs across the country and has a particular focus on women of color.
